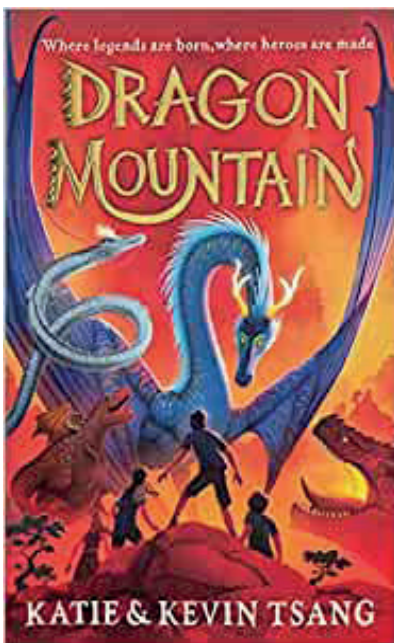




DRAGON MOUNTAIN

Synopsis

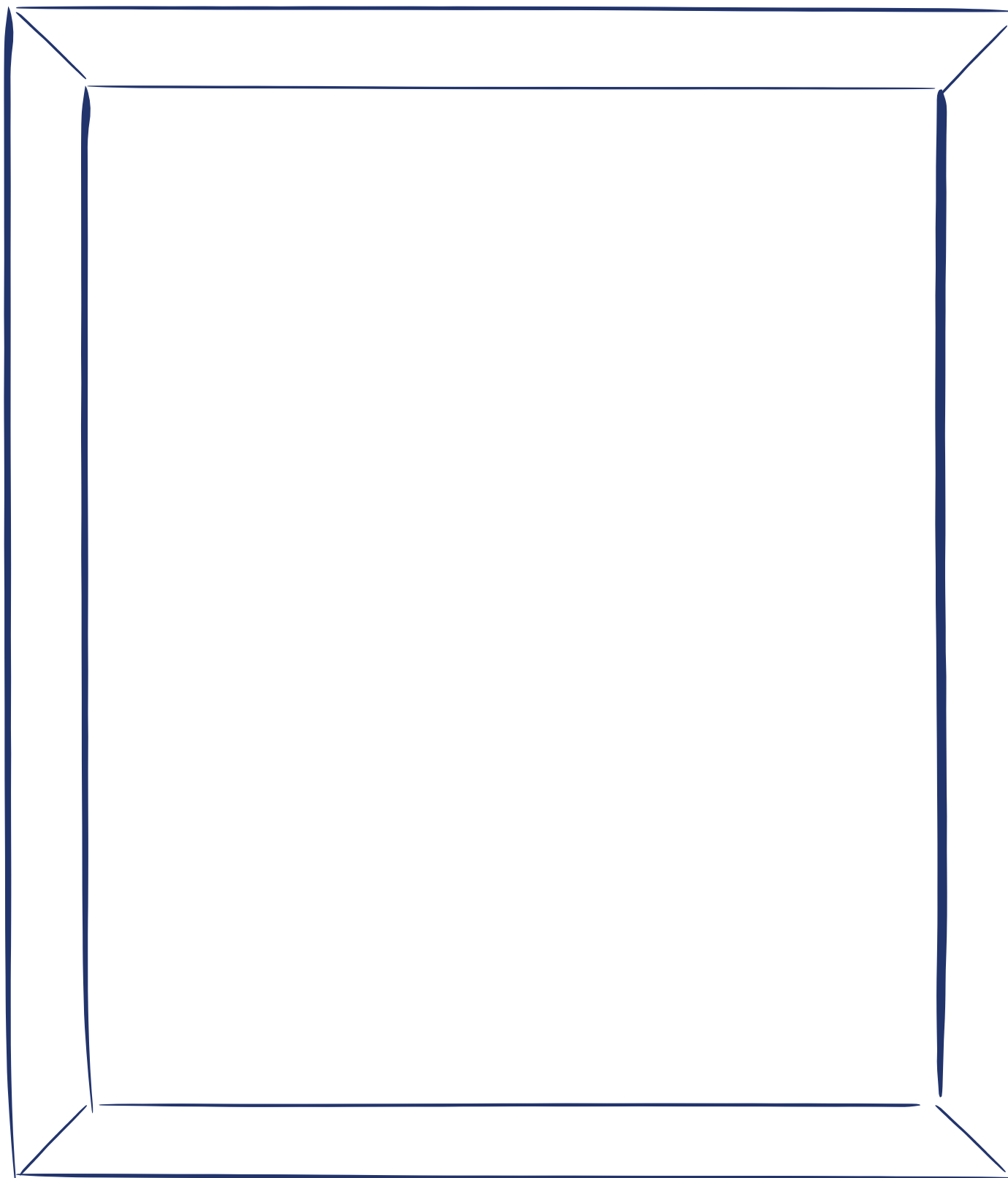
